
Instructors: Melissa Lang & Peter Burns **Description:** This class is designed for native English readers, writers and speakers, as well as advanced-level English language learning students. Participants will read, *Life of Pi* by Yann Martel. *Life of Pi* is a fictional novel about a boy from India who survives a shipwreck and travels 227 days in the Pacific Ocean. He is accompanied by a Bengal tiger and other animals.

Students will read 25-35 pages per week for homework, and in-class discussions will include the role of spirituality in one's life, resilience, self-reliance and survival. The nature of reality and how stories are told and perceived will also be explored.

Each week, students will be expected to produce one piece of writing chosen from a list of prompts. In class, they will share their writings and provide feedback to peers with a goal of helping one another become stronger writers.
